

At present, the Turkish composite sector has approximately 5,000 employees distributed in 150-200 middle and large-scale companies and 700-800 companies which are partly involved in composite business. The overall annual production is 200 thousand tons.



Fastest Growing Composites Market of Europe

The composite sector's growth rate in Turkey is higher than that of Europe and the rest of the world. Growth rates between 8% and 12% were seen in Turkey in the years before the economic downturn of 2008, during the recovery period the growth rate is between 9% and 10%.

Manufacturing Hub for Global Brands

Turkey is poised to become a manufacturing hub for global brands in the next few years, according to financial reports. Global brands are already looking at Turkey as a manufacturing base for their products, while others are sourcing their requirements from Turkey. The cost advantages of manufacturing in Turkey, particularly in labour intensive sectors, will influence the increasing manufacture of foreign brands in the country.

Steadily Growing Economy

The Turkish economy has shown remarkable performance with its steady growth over the last eight years. The structural reforms, hastened by Turkey's EU accession process, have paved the way for comprehensive changes in a number of areas. As these reforms have strengthened the macroeconomic fundamentals of the country, the economy grew with an average annual real GDP growth rate of 5.2 percent over the past nine years between 2002 and 2011.

Reasons to do business with Turkey

With a successful economy, high population, qualified and competitive laborforce, liberal and reformist investment climate, infrastructure, central location of the country, energy corridor and terminal of Europe,

low taxes and high incentives, customs union with EU since 1996 and large domestic market, Turkey represents an ideal place to centre manufacturing.


